CEN REVIEW COURSE

The course will review the major areas of test focus, while the provided syllabus will cover all test content, as established by the BCEN (July 2007). COURSE OBJECTIVES:

1. Recognize specific clinical presentations and symptoms indicative of specific emergency diagnoses.
2. Describe appropriate nursing interventions and medical treatment modalities for specific emergency conditions.
3. List appropriate pharmacological treatment modalities for specific emergency conditions.
